

## THE KNOTTED OAK

A four couple, 32 bar jig.

- 1-8 All four couples dance eight hands round and back.
- 9-12 First couple set once and cross over giving right hands.
- 13-14 First couple set.
- 15-16 First woman advances into the middle with pas de basque to finish facing down while  
first man dances a "Petronella" turn into the middle to finish facing down.
- 17-18 First man sets  
while  
first woman and second couple dance right hands across halfway round.
- 19-20 First man and second couple dance right hands across halfway round  
while  
first woman and third couple dance left hands across halfway round.
- 21-22 First man and third couple dance left hands across halfway round  
while  
first woman and fourth couple dance right hands across halfway round.  
First woman finishes in the middle below fourth place facing up.
- 23-24 First man and fourth couple dance right hands across halfway round  
while  
first woman sets.  
At the end of bar 24 first man turns right about on the spot to finish in the middle above  
fourth place facing first woman.
- During bars 17-24 supporting couples retain hands and dance three hands across once round  
moving up one place as they do so.
- 25-28 First couple set once and dance a "Petronella" turn to finish on own sides in fourth place.
- 29-32 All four couples turn partner with right hands once round.

Repeat with a new top couple.
